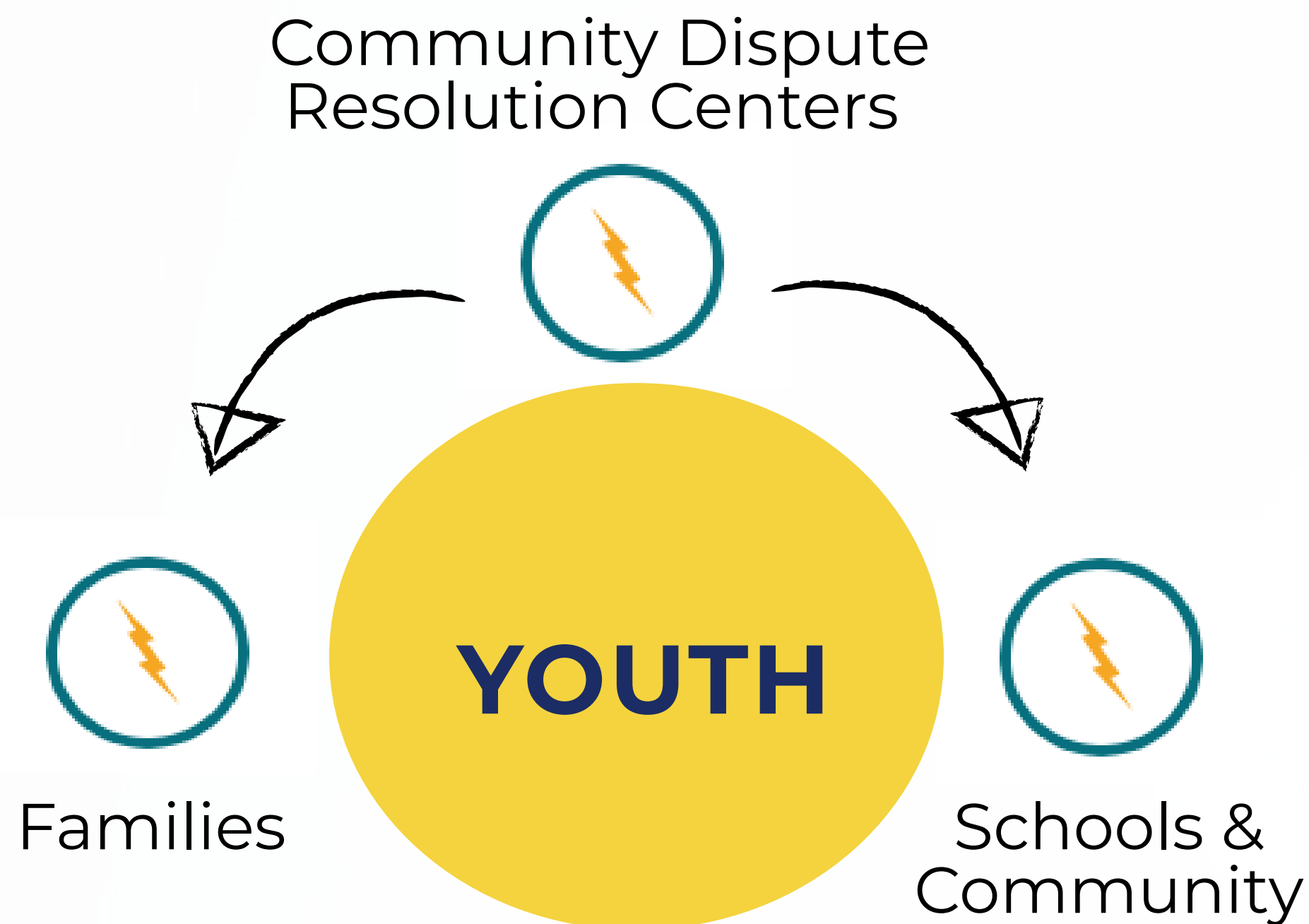




COMMUNITY MEDIATION SERVICE CORPS



WHAT IS CMSC AMERICORPS?



CMSC is a partnership between the New York State Dispute Resolution Association (NYSDRA) and Community Dispute Resolution Centers (CDRC) across New York. The CMSC program provides conflict resolution services to youth and families in local communities and schools.

WHAT DO CMSC MEMBERS DO?

All CMSC Members help strengthen local partnerships for CDRCs through outreach and other activities to improve outcomes for youth



School Based Member Placement

Full time members work on site at local schools providing a variety of ADR services



Family Services Member Placement

Full or Part time members provide case management and mediation services for custody and family visitation cases.



Youth Services Member Placement

Full or Part time members work with local youth justice agencies such as probation.
