

Basic Mediation Training Trainer: Kim Reisch

This 35-hour training introduces participants to the theory, principles, and practice of mediation in the Transformative Mediation framework to prepare to mediate community disputes as a volunteer with the Center for Dispute Settlement.

Participants will have the opportunity to:

- Explore their values, biases, and experiences with conflict.
- Understand the core values of mediation and standards of practice for community dispute resolution centers, like the Center for Dispute Settlement.
- Understand and practice the core activities of a mediator practicing with a transformative mediation orientation.
- Develop the ability to engage in a reflective practice of mediator self-assessment and continued learning.
